OVERVIEW OF B.Sc. NURSING

The B.Sc. nursing degree program is a four-year fulltime program comprising eight semesters, specified by Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS), Approved by Govt. of Kerala & Kerala Nurses and Midwives Council (KNMC), which prepares B.Sc. Nursing graduates qualified to practice nursing and midwifery in a variety of settings in either public / government or private health care settings.

ALLOTMENT OF SEATS

Government Quota: 30 Seats (50% of Total Seats)

- Government seats are those which the Director of Medical Education makes allotments.
- Admission of the seats will be made on the basis of merit.
- Admission process of allotment to Government merit seats (50%) under Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing will be done by the Director, LBS Centre for Science & Technology, under the supervision of the Director of Medical Education, as per the G.O (MS) No. 230/2023/H&FWD dated, 24/08/2023.
- Candidates are requested to visit the official website of LBS Centre www.lbscentre.kerala.gov.in for details.

Management Quota: 30 Seats (50% of Total Seats)

- These are the seats other than Government seats (50%) against which the Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing will make allotment.
- There will not be any type of reservation in the Management seats.
- Candidate shall pay the Tuition fees and Special fees, fixed by the Government.
- The eligibility for admission is same as for general merit and the candidate will be selected on merit basis.

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Candidates seeking admission for B.Sc. Nursing course should fulfil the following:

- Candidates who have passed higher secondary examinations of the Board of Higher Secondary Education, Govt. of Kerala or equivalent as recognized by Kerala University of Health Sciences (KUHS) with 50% marks in Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English put together are eligible for admission.
- Applicant should have completed 17 years of age on the 31st December 2023. For the proof of age, Self-attested copy of relevant page of School Record such as SSLC/ CBSE/ ICSE certificate or copy of birth certificate from appropriate authority should be furnished along with the application form.
- Applicants who have passed the qualifying examination from the universities / boards outside Kerala shall produce the eligibility certificate from KUHS and Migration certificate from the universities/ boards concerned.

DURATION

Duration of the B.Sc. Nursing course shall be four years, which is a credit and semester-based program, comprising of eight semesters including Internship. The maximum period to complete the B.Sc. Nursing course successfully shall not exceed twice the actual duration of the Course (Eight years).

HOW TO APPLY

- Application for admission and prospectus are available online through college website. Visit website for details (<https://www.igmcn.org/>).
- The application fee is Rs.500/-for all candidates, payable through online by using Credit/ Debit/ Internet Banking facility.
- The candidate should have a valid email id.
- After filling up all necessary information and uploading details of marks and necessary documents, the candidates can pay the fee for application in online mode.
- The application submission will be completed only after successful payment of application fee through online.

- Once submission of application and payment of fee is successful, candidate will receive an electronically generated receipt to his/ her registered email.
- After submission of application in online mode candidates shall take a print out of the same, which shall be submitted to the Principal, Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing at the time of interview for admission.
- Submission of more than one application by a candidate will lead to rejection of the candidature.
- Application fee once remitted will not be refunded in any circumstances.
- Self-attested copies of the following certificates shall be enclosed with the application form as shown below.
 1. S.S.L.C Certificate/ Equivalent/ Birth certificate
 2. Plus two Certificate/ Equivalent (with mark list)
 3. Nativity Certificate
 4. Course Certificate issued by the Head of the Educational Institutions last attended.
 5. Copy of TC and Conduct certificate.
 6. Copy of equivalency certificate and migration (Only for out of Kerala candidate)
 7. Copy of application fee payment details for admission
 8. Caste certificate and income certificate in case of communities with reservation benefit (SC/ ST/ OBC/ OEC/ EBW etc.)
 9. Passport Size Photographs (4 Nos)
- Incomplete/ belated applications will be rejected.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

Selection of candidates will be based on merit list prepared on the basis of the marks obtained in plus two or qualifying examination. Candidates should bring all the documents in original for verification at the time of admission. Any false information will lead to cancellation of admission.

Preparation of merit list

Marks of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English in Higher Secondary Examination will be considered for preparation of merit list. If the marks are equal, marks of Biology will be taken, followed by Physics and Chemistry. If all these are equal, date of Birth of candidate will be considered i.e. with person of higher age getting preference over the younger.

** CBSE/ ICSE Senior Secondary Examination marks will be equated with Higher Secondary marks of Kerala syllabus by approved normalization process.

Publication of Rank List

The rank lists will be published in the college website <https://igmcn.org/> on the date notified.

ADMISSION

Selected candidates will be informed the date and time of interview and admission, in due course, through website. Candidates are requested to visit the Official Website of Indira Gandhi Memorial College of Nursing regularly for notifications and announcements. Selected candidates for admission under Management quota are requested to remit fee into the bank.

- All the selected students should get themselves vaccinated against Hepatitis B before admission. Certificates to the effect should be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.
- Physical Fitness Certificate (Certified by a Registered Medical Practitioner) should be produced at the time of admission or before commencement of the course.

COURSE FEE

The fee structure shown below was fixed by Govt. / Fee Regulatory Committee for the 2023 admission. Any revision in the fee structure ordered by the competent authorities for the current academic year will have to be paid by the candidate.

Annual fee should be paid before commencing the next academic year irrespective of academic status of the student.

DISCONTINUATION

In case of discontinuation of course after closing admission, the entire course fee has to be paid by the candidate as liquidated damages. Transfer Certificate will be issued only after payment of full fees.

EXAMINATION

Regular University Examination are conducted at the end of each semester and supplementary examination as notified by KUHS Examination fees shall be remitted by the candidate as stipulated by the University from time to time.

ELIGIBILITY FOR APPEARING EXAMINATION

- A candidate must have a minimum of 80% attendance in theory and practical in each subject for appearing for University Examination. A minimum of 80% attendance in all the non-exam going subjects in the concerned semester also is essential for registering a candidate for the university examination.
- The candidate must secure 50% marks for internal assessment in theory and practical, wherever is applicable in order to be eligible to appear in the university examination of the subject. Minimum pass mark shall be 40% for Communicative English and Elective modules.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

College

1. Students shall strictly observe professional conduct and high standards of discipline.
2. Students should maintain decorum and dignity in the College, Hospital & Hostel.
3. As per clause 7 of the Rules and Regulations of the University and Judgment of Honorable Courts regarding the conduct of students in campus, the management has the right to stall organizational activities of student's organization directly or through their member students in the campus. An under taking to this effect be given by the students and their parents at the time of admission.
4. Ragging in any form is strictly prohibited in the College and Hostel. If any incident of ragging occurs, strict action will be taken as per the latest direction of the Honorable Supreme Court.
5. Use of mobile phone by the students is strictly prohibited in class, clinics and during working hours. If found in use, it will be confiscated.
6. Use of Drugs / Smoking / Alcoholism etc. are strictly prohibited in class /Compound/ Clinics/ Hostel. Any violation lead to dismissal from the college.
7. Any type of in disciplinary behavior (whistling, passing comments, exhibiting posters, spreading rumors, shouting etc.) towards teachers, other students or staff will not be tolerated and will be subjected to major disciplinary actions.
8. Any change in the contact address / telephone number of student / parent should be informed to the College immediately. College will not be responsible for any delay / non receipt of information / communication due to the Change in address.
9. The institution shall not be liable in the delay / loss in communication owing to failure of postal / courier service.

10. Each student should report for class / clinical in the specified time. Late comers will not be allowed to attend class / clinics.
11. Students should inform class coordinator/ concerned teacher about any inability to attend classes and should submit the leave letter in time. Absenteeism from class / clinics without prior information will be marked as double absence along with other disciplinary actions.

Uniform

Students are to follow dress code strictly in class and clinical area as specified by the institution.

Hostel

Hostel facility is available for both Boy's and Girls'. Hostel fee for Girls ₹5,250 /- per month & for Boys ₹ 5,750/- per month, it may change according to the fluctuations of prices of commodities in the market.

1. Admission to College Hostel will be according to the availability.
2. The whole year Hostel fee should be remitted before the starting of every Academic Year.
3. Hostel establishment fees ₹ 14,000 (One Time - at the time of Admission).
4. Hostel Caution deposit ₹ 5,000/- and admission fee ₹1,000/-
5. Hostel Policy should abide by all the Hostel's inmates

Mess Facility

1. Hostel inmates will get mess facility.
2. The Mess dues of current Month will have to be settled before 5th of next month.
3. The students shall not avail Mess Cut facility
